If citing language data in text, italicize the data and provide a gloss, as for ʔayʔajuθəm *mimaw'* ‘cat’. Use the Expex package for representing linguistic examples set off from the text, as in (1). The leipzig package can be used for interlinear glosses, as in (2).

(2) An ʔayʔajuθəm example:

hił k^w=ča niʔs t^θ=mimaw'
be DET=where be.there-3POSS 1POSS=cat

‘Where is my cat?’
